- Experimenting, reflecting, and taking action on ideas in the real world



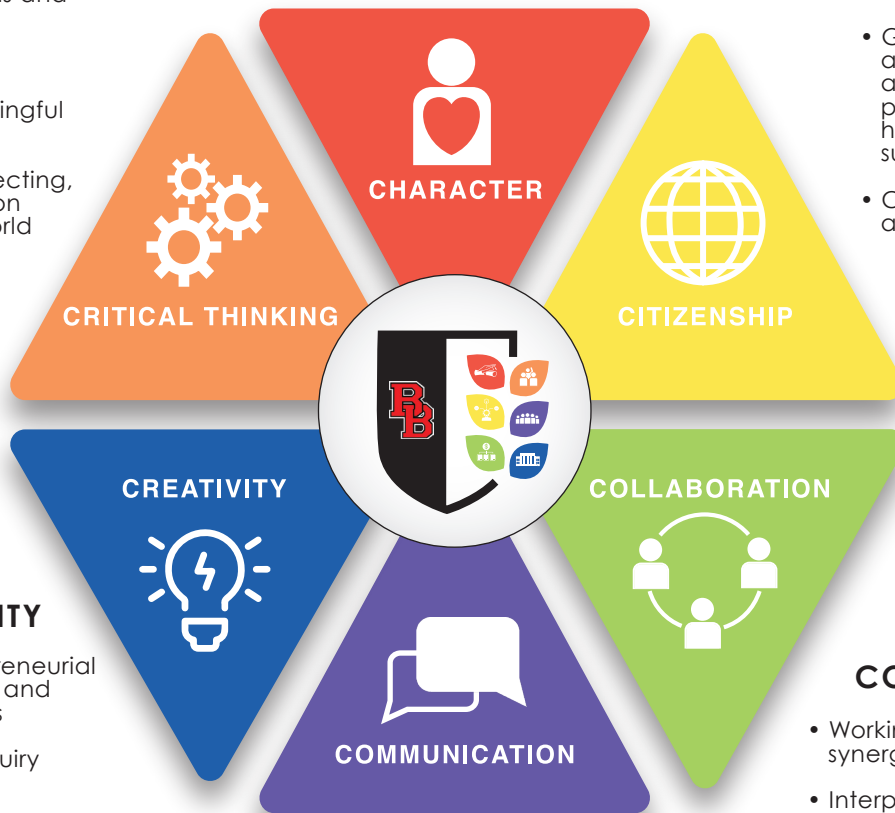
## CHARACTER
