## TYPE 1 DIABETIC CRISIS



HYPOGLYCEMIA: LOW BLOOD SUGAR LEVELS

- \* SYMPTOMS- HUNGER, FATIGUE, SWEATY, RAPID HEART RATE, NAUSEA, CHANGES IN BEHAVIOR SHOULD BE ESCORTED TO THE NURSE
- \* EMERGENCY- LOSS OF CONSCIOUSNESS OR SEIZURE CALL 911 AND FOR NURSING ASSISTANCE

HYPERGLYCEMIA: HIGH BLOOD SUGAR LEVELS

\* SYMPTOMS- INCREASED THIRST, TIREDNESS, NAUSEA, ABDOMINAL PAIN, HEADACHE

# RECOGNIZE AND ASSISTING WITH SEIZURES



#### COMMON SYMPTOMS OF SEIZEURE:

- \* CONFUSION
- \* STARING
- \* UNCONTROLLABLE, JERKING MOVEMENTS
- \* LOSS OF CONSCIOUSNESS OR AWARENESS

#### HOW TO RESPOND:

- \* Ensure the Person is in a safe enviroment
  - \* THE PERSON SHOULD BE ON THE GROUND AND CLEAR OF ANY HAZARDS
- \* TURN THE PERSON ON THEIR SIDE TO PREVENT CHOKING
- \* CALL FOR THE SCHOOL NURSE OR ADMINSTRATIVE ASSISTANT AND 911

#### Allergic Reactions - Anaphylaxis

- Mild Symptoms: sneezing, itchy nose or mouth, nausea, itchy skin with few hives
  - Escort to the nurse's office for monitoring and medication
- Severe Symptoms: anxiety, swelling of lips/tongue, shortness of breath, wheezing, throat tightness, trouble swallowing, dizziness, vomiting, pale skin, many hives
  - Call 911
  - Place the individual on the floor
  - Call for nursing support for the emergency use of Epinephrine
    - Repeat of Epinephrine if no relief after 5 minutes

### **CHECK- CALL-CARE**

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- 1. CHECK THE SCENE FOR SAFETY- CHECK PERSON FOR CONSCIOUSNESS
  - A. UNCONSCIOUS: CHECK PERSON BY TAPPING ON THEIR SHOULDER
    AND ASKING "ARE YOU OKAY?"
  - B. CONSCIOUS: ASK IF THEY ARE CHOKING AND ASK IF YOU CAN HELP THEM.
- 2. CALL 911 OR NURSE AMY AND BETH (EXT. 6019/6026)
  - A. SPECIFICS- NATURE OF INJURY, STATE OF CONSIDUSNESS
- 3. CARE FOR THE PERSON

### Conscious choking

#### Universal sign of choking:

- Hands around the throat
Look of panic, unable to talk,
Strained of noisy breathing
Lips, skin, nails change color

PAIN/PRESSURE IN CHEST

- \* LIGHT HEADED/ DIZZY
  - \* SHORTNESS OF BREATH
    - \* "REFERRED PAIN"

      ARMS/ LEFT SIDE

      BACK/ NECK/ JAW

### CARDIAC ARREST

\* SUDDEN FAINTING/ PASSING OUT

\* NO RESPONSE

\* NOT BREATHING
