

JOEL DAVID KUIKEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This award is in memory of Joel David Kuiken, a 1995 graduate of Bradley Bourbonnais Community High School. He continued his studies at several different colleges and universities in his attempt to prepare for a degree in law. In May of 1999, Joel was diagnosed with the AML strain of leukemia. In August of 2000, he lost his battle with the disease.

In honor of Joel and his wishes to become a lawyer and his fifteen-month medical battle for his life, one thousand dollars (\$1,000) will be awarded to two (2) individual qualified applicants.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The applicant must have applied and been accepted to a 4 year, 2 year college or vocational school of his/her choice.
2. The applicant must have at least a GPA of a 3.0 (on a 4 pt scale) at Bradley Bourbonnais Community High School.
3. The applicant must have a financial need or in need of financial assistance.

CRITERIA:

Applications will be judged on the following criteria:

1. Scholastic achievement
2. Selected area of study
3. Career goals upon graduation
4. Church/community service
5. Financial need

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Fill out the informational section below.
2. Attach a copy of your high school transcript.
3. Attach a copy of your letter of acceptance to the college, university or trade school you plan to attend.
4. Attach a current photo of yourself (if possible).
5. Attach an essay that describes yourself, your major, and your career goals upon graduation.
6. An interview.
