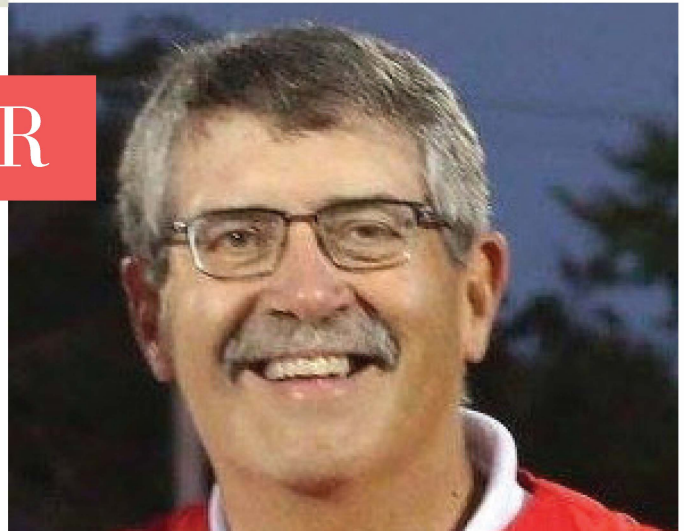


PIZZA WARS 2020
