



MIKE DOWNEY

2020 Alumnus of the Year



Bill Gamble, retired Principal of BBCHS, nominated Mike Downey, Class of 1980 for the 2020 Alumnus of the Year award.

My first interaction with Mike was when he was working as an official and I was coaching basketball at Reed-Custer High School. As you would expect, we didn't always agree on what we were seeing. As time moved forward, our paths crossed again at BBCHS. He was a Board Member and I was hired as Athletic Director and then became the Principal. His passion and desire to make BBCHS a better school was clear from our first meetings. Mike truly cared about the experience and education that the students received during their four years. He served as a member of the Board of Education for BBCHS from 1993-2019. During that time, he held the position as Secretary of the BOE for 10 years. When one thinks of Mike Downey, School Board Member, the words respect and trust come instantly to your mind. I am proud to call him a friend.

After graduating from BBCHS in 1980, he attended college at Western Illinois University. He graduated in 1985 with a Bachelor of Science in Law Enforcement Administration. Our community was lucky to have him return to our area. He began working in the criminal justice system in Kankakee County as an Adult Probation Officer following graduation. In January of 1995, he was hired as the Chief of Corrections for the Kankakee County Sheriff's Office.

His professional development accomplishments are truly impressive, some examples being: Completing the 12-week Basic Police Training Academy in December of 1997, Graduating from Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command in 2002, in 2005, Mike was one of four Certified Jail Managers in the State of Illinois, and Graduating from the 10-week F.B.I. National Academy in Quantico, Va. One of his most important accomplishments was being instrumental in the design of the new jail which opened up in 2005. In 2014 he was appointed to the position of Undersheriff and on May 10, 2016 was appointed as Sheriff following Sheriff Bukowski's retirement. Mike was elected Sheriff in November 2016 to fulfill the remainder of Sheriff Bukowski's term and elected to a four-vear term in November of 2018. His commitment to our community is unquestioned. In addition to the school board and his role as sheriff, Mike has found time to be an IHSA basketball official for 30 years, officiating jr. high, high school and small college games. He was the assignor for 20 years for the River Valley Conference and Interstate 8 Conference for both boys and girls basketball. In addition, Mike has served as a volunteer coach for Bradlev-Bourbonnais Little League, Bradlev-Bourbonnais Pony League, Maternity BVM and Lorenzo Smith Jr High School in Pembroke. In summary, he has been a positive influence on many people. Those of us who know Mike realize quickly the most important part of his life is his family. He has been married 34 years to Meghan (Martin) Downey. They have two children Kevin (Abby) & Shawn who both graduated from BBCHS, and 1 granddaughter, Sloan. If he is not working or spending time with his family, you can find Mike golfing or watching the Chicago Cubs. This recognition is well deserved. Mike truly represents Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School with class at all times.

Those years pass quickly and except for reunions or social media contacts, the past only occupies an occasional recollection of youthful memories as we move on to other, hopefully better, places in our lives. As those memories become faded and foggy, many forget by design or distraction that sense of time and place of our less complicated phase. As I remember Adam Karr to be a quiet, uncelebrated achiever who clearly had ambitions beyond his Boilermaker years, I know that the current place in the resume of his life has not crowded out his awareness of where he came from. Adam has grown so much in so many ways since 1989 and yet his humility keeps him grounded and respectful of where his starting gates were set.

Karr is the managing director at Orbis Investment Management. He and his wife Tonia have endowed scholarships at Northwestern, Stanford, Harvard and **BBCHS**. Adam and his wife have created and endowed several scholarships focused on providing support to students of color interested in teaching at inner city schools.




