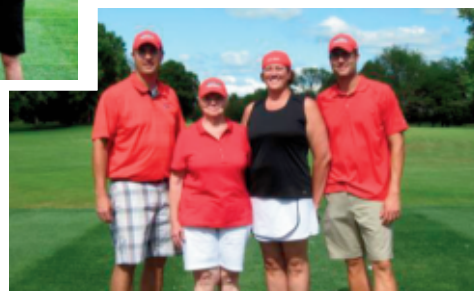

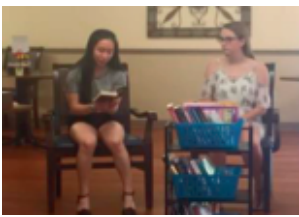
Student Service Projects

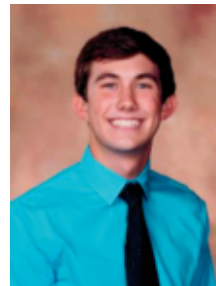
